JEREMIAH 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you," says Yahweh, "thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you hope and a future.

Lord, thank you that you have a good plan for us, and our marriage, and we claim Your hope and Your future for us in Jesus Name.

1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-8

Love is patient and is kind. Love doesn't envy. Love doesn't brag, is not proud, doesn't behave itself inappropriately, doesn't seek its own way, is not provoked, takes no account of evil; doesn't rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. PSALM 1:1-3

ECCLESIASTES 4:9-12

ROMANS 15:5-6

HEBREWS 10:24

2 CORINTHIANS 12:9

Prayers for your Marriage

ISAIAH 64:8

GALATIANS 5:22-23

EPHESIANS 4:29

PHILIPPIANS 2:3-7

JAMES 4:8

Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners. Purify your hearts, you double-minded.

JAMES 5:16

Confess your offenses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The insistent prayer of a righteous person is powerfully effective.

Help us Lord in our forgiveness of each other, and also as we need to ask for forgiveness, remembering Your grace in forgiving us. Help us to hold each other in prayer and continue to lift each other up and encourage each other.
