

HOW TO USE

Inside you will find Psalm 23 broken down into 6 passages/scriptures. This will enable you to take your time to reflect on each verse and memorise the passage. You may feel overwhelmed at first, but remember this can be done at your own pace. You can choose to do one a day or one a week, the important thing is that you're committing to spend time with the Lord on a regular basis.

METHOD

It's always a good idea to pray before you start your Bible study. Ask God to remove any distractions from your mind and ask Him to show you what He wants you to learn.

READ

Read the passage. You may want to read it a few times or even read it out loud.

BIBLE VERSE

This is where you write out the passage you have just read. Writing it down will help you memorise the verse and help you reflect more deeply on what it is saying to you.

KEYWORD

This is for any words that jump out at you. You may want to write down the meaning of the word in the space provided.

EXAMINE

Look through the passage and see what is happening. This may include things like who, what, when, where, why, how. What is going on in the passage in relation to the context, time it was written and who was writing it. Think about the scripture and ask yourself, what stands out to you, what do you observe, who is the audience, is there something you see that you haven't seen before, is there repetition, are there comparisons or contrasts. Write down your observations.

APPLY

Ask yourself, how can I apply what I have read to myself, my life, and my walk with the Lord, is there something I need to do, or change. It may not always be something you need to 'do' or 'change' but it may be something you learn about God that changes your relationship with Him, or that you want to add to your praise and worship. Write down how you will apply what you have learned.

PRAY

Pray about what God has shown you. Pray through what you have learned, ask God to work in your life through what you have learned, it may involve praise, it may involve confession, it may be asking for help to act on something. (Matthew 13:23)
